

I, the undersigned player or the parent or legal guardian of a minor player named below, acknowledge, agree and understand that: 1) Voluntarily and of my own free will, I elect to participate as a member of the Easton Spring Softball School ("ESSS") indicated below. 2) I understand that there are certain risks and hazards involved in participating in the ESSS and playing softball including, but not limited to those hazards associated with weather conditions, playing conditions, equipment and other participants in addition to the acts of pitching, throwing, fielding and catching of the ball, running, jumping, stretching, sliding, diving and collisions with other players and with stationary objects, all of which can cause serious injury or death to me and to other players. Further, I agree that in consideration for the right to play as a member of ESSS designated below and in consideration for permission to play on the premises arranged for by ESSS: 1) I voluntarily elect or accept and solely assume all risk of damages, injury, including death, incurred or suffered by me (a) while practicing or playing as a member of ESSS so designated, (b) while serving in a non-playing capacity as a member ESSS or observer during practice of play by other teams or by other players on my team, and (c) while on or upon the premise of any and all of the premises arranged for by ESSS for practice or play. 2) I release, discharge and agree not to sue ESSS or its owners, officers, agents, servants, associations, employees, or any person or entity connected with ESSS, or any owner or lessee of premises arranged on which Softball is played or practiced for any claim, damages, costs or cause of action which I have or may in the future have as a result of injuries or damages sustained or incurred by me for whatever cause including but not limited to the negligence, breach of contract or wrongful conduct of the parties hereby released. I further agree that I shall hold harmless and fully indemnify the parties hereby released from any claims, damages, costs including attorney fees, and cause of action which may arise from any claim or cause of action made by me, through me or on my behalf even if the damages, injuries or death are caused in whole or in part by any of the parties or entities hereby released.

I acknowledge, affirm, and agree that I have had sufficient opportunity to read this entire WAIVER & RELEASE OF LIABILITY & CONSENT TO MEDICAL TREATMENT, that I understand its content, and that it is legally binding, and that I execute it freely, intelligently, and without duress of any kind and I agree to be bound by its terms.
